#### Kindergarten Classes for 2016

#### Class Placements for 2016

The very important process of establishing classes for the new school year will be underway in the next few weeks. Requests for special consideration for placement for your child will only be considered on academic grounds.

Parents and caregivers now have the opportunity to make the school aware of any individual educational needs that may be given special consideration in class placements. This does not guarantee that the student is placed in the class of parent choice but rather adds to the information that is available to staff in making decisions in forming classes. Parents wishing to make such requests should make them in writing, to the Principal and deliver the request to the school between Friday November 6<sup>th</sup> and November 20<sup>th</sup> 2015 for the request to be considered.

Please note that whilst we will have completed our initial class lists by the end of the current school year we will not display them until Wednesday 27 January 2016. This enables us to include new enrolments on the class lists that I am sure will occur before the start of the new school.

Congratulations to all the students for their participation and good sportsmanship. Thank you to Mr Ellam for organizing all the teams and teaching us the games.


