



2019 Charges and School Contributions

Dear Parents and Caregivers

The Education Act 1999 requires schools to notify parents of all contributions and charges prior to the start of the school year. These costs are divided into four areas: **School Contributions, Charges, Student Requirement List and Extra Cost Options**. These costs have been endorsed by the Hammond Park Primary Independent Public School Board.

- **School Contributions:** A voluntary school contribution towards the cost of items used in the educational program provided for your child.
 - **Extra Cost Items:** An estimate of the costs of these items is listed for non-compulsory activities. Payment for these items is a condition of participation by students.
 - **Student Requirement List:** Items on this list are required for students use in their classroom.
1. The Hammond Park Primary Independent Public School Board has endorsed an amount of \$60.00 per student as a **School Contribution for 2019**. This equates to approximately \$1.50 per week. These contributions are voluntary. They enhance the teaching and learning opportunities for all students and supplement funding gained from other sources, including the State and Federal governments. At Hammond Park Primary School, the **School Contributions** will be used to purchase supplementary materials and resources used in classrooms in the following areas:
- Visual Arts Materials
 - Literacy and Numeracy Resources
 - History, Geography and Science Resources
 - Class cooking activities
 - Information Communication Technology (ICT) Resources
 - Library Books

2. Student Requirement List

The cost for items on this list will vary from year level to year level. It includes items such as pens, pencils and scrapbooks. Parents may purchase these items from their chosen retailer or use the nominated school supplier **Ziggies Educational Supplies**. The school receives a small commission for each order processed through this company.

You can also pay your **School Contribution** of \$60 per student for 2019 through **Ziggies Educational Supplies** when you order your child's Student Requirements.

This contribution can also be paid at the school office at any time, online by direct deposit, or through the QKR app.

3. Extra Cost Items

This amount can vary from year to year and from class to class. A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in excursions/in-school activities and swimming lessons etc for 2019 has been outlined in the schedule attached. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum that can be charged for scheduled activities in 2019. **Students can only participate if they have parental permission and have paid the charge.** This money will be used to fund the following types of activities: *visiting performers, excursions, interschool sports carnivals, swimming lessons and other special events.*

The excursions/in school activities charge can be paid in advance at the beginning of the year and any excursions/in school performances that your child attends, will be deducted from this amount. Any money left in your child's account at the end of the 2018, will be carried forward into 2019.

4. Voluntary Additional Requests

This money is used by the school to provide additional opportunities for all students. They include but are not limited to items such as iPad/Mac Book Co-contributions.

iPad/Mac Co Contribution (K – Yr. 6)

The Australian Curriculum expects that students learn to use ICT effectively and appropriately to access, create and communicate information and ideas, solve problems and work collaboratively in all learning areas at school. Together, the teachers and School Board have researched current ICT best practice in education, along with Hammond Park's current and future capacity to deliver this. With an average ratio of 1:3 iPads to students across the school and 1:3 Macbooks to students in years 3-6 a \$60 co-contribution for PP-Year 6 and \$30 co-contribution for Kindergarten, will help us establish and maintain high ratios of access to technology for students.
