

Kindy Information 2022

Welcome to 2022! The Kindy's have made a fantastic start and we are looking forward to an exciting year ahead. Listed below are a few reminders and information about Kindy 2022 at Hammond Park Primary School. For more information, please refer to the Kindy 2022 handbooks that were given out at the parent information session last year.

Daily Procedure

Doors opens at 8.30am. Before your child enters the classroom, please read the morning message board with them. When the doors open, please support your child to be independent by assisting them to place their own water bottle and crunch and sip into the container provided. Currently, due to Covid restrictions parents are unable to enter classrooms. When handing your child over in the morning, say a quick goodbye and send them inside to get settled for the day. Please ensure they have their 'Crunch and Sip' and water bottle before entering the room. If your child is struggling to separate, we suggest you say a quick goodbye, teachers will provide assistance when required. Please be assured if your child continues to be upset we will contact you. Most students settle in a few minutes after parents have left.

Parent Communication

We communicate and share updates with parents through the 'Seesaw' app. Please scan the QR code which will connect you to your child's journal. This can be accessed online through the website, and on Apple and Android devices. It is a free, secure service that allows for easy communication between home and school. Photos of what we have been doing in class as well as daily reminders will be posted on here regularly. Please remember the QR code provided is for your use only (Parent/Guardian). These codes can only be issued once you have completed the ICT agreement, QR codes for these can be found outside each classroom.

There will also be a communication book in the classroom for the teachers to write in, so please let us know of any changes in drop off/ pick up as well as if your child has a lunch order.

Parent Help

In Kindy, we greatly appreciate having parent help in the classroom. To allow students to settle into classroom routines, we hope to start parent help in Term 2, Week 5. A roster will be displayed on the window of the classroom for you to sign up. Parent help is between 8.40am -10.10am. Please ensure you sign in at the office at the start of the day and get a visitor's tag. As a parent helper you will be involved in small group activities with the students as well as preparation for classroom activities.

Change of Clothes

Toileting accidents can occur when your child is at school or they may get wet during water play activities. Please make sure there is a **clearly labelled** complete change of clothes in your child's bag. Please change these to match the season.

Crunch and Sip

Students need a labelled container of fruit and/or vegetables that is **separate** from the rest of their lunchbox. This container is placed into the 'Crunch and Sip' container in the classroom and is eaten during class time. We also encourage students to drink **water** throughout the day.

Canteen

The canteen will be available to order recess, 'Crunch and Sip' and lunch every Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. There is no canteen on Tuesday.

Recess and Lunch Play (Shoes Off Policy)

At HPPS during play time, students may take their shoes off to play in the playground. We encourage them to be able to put their shoes and socks on and off independently if they participate in 'shoes off' play.

Kindy Programs

In Kindy, the students have a variety of integrated table activities to choose from as well as areas of the classroom, for example the home corner and construction. Students also complete activities with the Education Assistants and the teacher linking to our curriculum focus.

Hammond Park Play Philosophy: Our vision is to equip students with the necessary skills to become confident, independent and inquisitive learners. We believe balanced play-based experiences support student's social, emotional and physical development. Therefore, our Kindy classrooms follow a play-based approach to learning. We give students opportunities to co-construct their learning, work collaboratively and embrace the school's philosophy of "Learning Together Everyday". We provide interactive, engaging, flexible and supportive learning experiences through our outdoor and indoor environments.

English: In Kindy, we implement the *Letters and Sounds* program, focusing on Phase One that encourages the development of speaking and listening skills through music, dance and oral language games. We also follow a pre-writing program called *'Writing in the Sand'* which forms the foundation for effective handwriting.

By the end of Kindy, students should be able to:

- Recognise their name as well as correctly form the letters of their name.
- Hear and clap syllables in words.
- Discriminate rhyme in words.
- Identity simple punctuation including a full stop and a question mark.
- Recognise that numbers are different than letters.
- Hear and begin to identify initial sounds in simple words.
- Retell a simple story.

Mathematics: The Maths lessons include an explicit mat session as well as table activities.

By the end of Kindy, students should be able to:

- Recognise numbers to 10 as well as being able order them and identify a missing number.
- Count objects using one to one correspondence.
- Copy simple patterns.
- Using appropriate language, describe, compare and order length, size, mass and height.
- Recognise and sort two dimensional shapes such as square, triangle, rectangle and circle.

Library

Library will commence in Term Two. Hopefully, Kindy students will go to the Library on a Wednesday to swap over their books, alternatively books will be brought to Kindy for them to borrow. Please make sure your child has a labelled library bag that is suitable to fit a large book in.

Birthdays

Due to COVID restrictions we ask that if you wish to celebrate your child's birthday with a special treat you either order cupcakes, brownies or icy poles from the Canteen or bring in packaged treats to be shared e.g. Freddos, with clearly marked ingredients.

Home Reading, Term Three

In Term Three, Kindy students will participate in a pre-reading program. This program helps students establish a love of reading as well as pre-reading skills of turning the pages, using pictures to retell the story and answering questions about what happens in the book. More information will become available closer to the commencement of the program.

A few reminders

- If you are coming to school late or picking your child up early, you will need to go through the office before coming to the classroom.
- If you need to contact your classroom teacher urgently please ring the office.
- Please inform your classroom teacher of any medical conditions/changes in your child's health.
- If your child requires any medication to be given at school, a form will need to be signed at the front office.
- Notify the office of any absences/holidays you have planned. Absences can be sent via SMS on 0437 780 341.
- Please ring the front office if there are any last-minute changes to pick-ups at the end of the day.
- If you have any concerns or queries, please do not hesitate in contacting your classroom teacher to arrange a time to meet before or after school. Please ensure you inform your child's teacher if your child is seeing an OT/Physio or a Speech Therapist so that we can best support your child in the classroom setting.
